

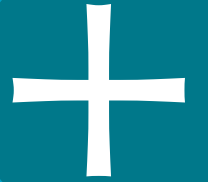

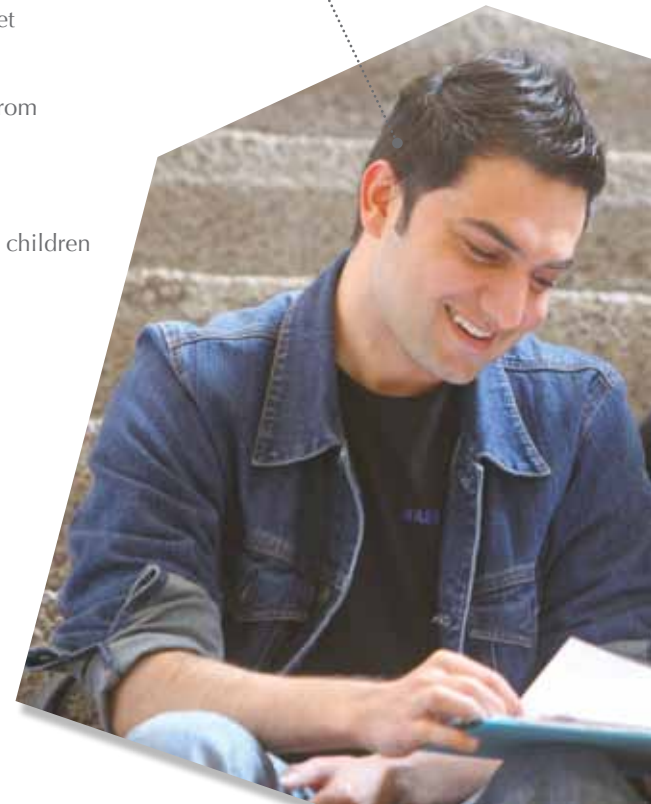

## BACHELOR OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH (AFTER DEGREE)

Our health and wellness depends on clean air, water, and soil, as well as safe communities and food. Concordia's innovative Bachelor of Environmental Health (After Degree) is one of only five programs in Canada that prepares you to challenge the certification examination for the Canadian Institute of Public Health Inspectors (check it out at [ciphi.ca](http://ciphi.ca)).

Kick start your career in public health. Students undertake an intensive 60-credit program involving 12 months of academic study followed by a three-month practicum field experience or research project.

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be considered for this program, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Completion of a three- or four-year science degree from a recognized college or university
- A minimum admission grade point average (GPA) of 2.3
- Completion of twelve senior-level science credits
- Completion of three credits in university-level English or writing
- Evidence of proficiency in computer knowledge and use
- Provide a resume and statement of career objectives highlighting related work and volunteer experience

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Admission to the Master of Arts in Biblical and Christian Studies degree program is competitive.

To be considered, applicants must present the following requirements:

- Completion of 36 undergraduate credits in Religious Studies at an accredited university, including 6 credits in one of the following concentration areas:
  - Hebrew Scripture
  - New Testament
  - Christian Theology/History
- A minimum admission grade point average (AGPA) of 3.0 or equivalent on the most recent 60 credits of undergraduate or graduate study
- Six credits in a language other than English
- A recent written sample of work, normally a research paper, produced in the last two years of a BA program
- Statement of Interest (500 words)
- Two letters of reference as described under "Admissions Requirements" in the most recent calendar

- Four-year Bachelor's degree from a recognized institution (preferably in Business, Engineering or Computing Science) or Applied Bachelor's degree with three years work experience
- A minimum admission grade point average (AGPA) of 3.0
- A security clearance
- Demonstrated fulfillment of Concordia's English Language Requirements, as described under "Admission Requirements" in the most recent calendar

### PROGRAM (LFP)

Concordia's University and College Entrance Program (UCEP) and Learning Foundations Program (LFP) are fast tracked, intensive eight month programs for students 20 years of age or older.

UCEP has two streams – Aboriginal and General – both of which cover concepts from grade 10, 11, and 12, enabling you to achieve necessary course equivalents for admission into post-secondary institutions. LFP provides basic academic skill development to prepare you for entrance into high school credit courses (including UCEP and other academic upgrading programs).

### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Students applying for the UCEP of the LFP programs are placed in the appropriate program based on an evaluation of placement testing, previous schooling, and interview. To be considered, applicants must:

- Be 20 years of age or older
- Complete a Math and English placement test
- Complete an individual career investigation report
- Complete an individual assessment interview

## UNIVERSITY ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP

Concordia believes you deserve a reward for your hard work. If you're entering your first year of university in Arts, Science or Management you could be rewarded up to \$15,000 based on your admission average! Our university entrance scholarships are renewable for up to four years (or until the completion of your degree), based on your GPA and course load.

*If you apply for admission before April 1 with a minimum admission average of 75%, you qualify!*

## PRESIDENT'S LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship covers full tuition costs and provides a \$1,250 cash award for up to four years. It's awarded to first-year students who have exceptional academic standings and demonstrate leadership in their communities. All students with an 85% admission average (or higher) are invited to apply.

*Applications for this scholarship are due April 1st.*

## APPLICATION CHECKLIST

#### STEP ONE

Decide which program you'd like to apply to and check for that program's application deadline. If you're not sure which program is for you, or if you meet the admission requirements, move on to step two.

#### STEP TWO

#### STEP THREE

Visit our website – [concordia.ab.ca](http://concordia.ab.ca) – and follow the “Apply Now” button at the top of the page that brings you to the ApplyAlberta site. Follow the steps to set up an account and to apply.

#### STEP FOUR

Have your transcripts and admission documents sent to Concordia.

Concordia can request transcripts on your behalf from Alberta Education and some Alberta post-secondary institutions. When you complete your online application, you'll be notified which transcripts Concordia can request and which ones you'll need to request.

#### STEP FIVE

We'll acknowledge your application once it's received and advise you of the next steps to take.
