While your degree planning is directed by the specific requirements for your chosen concentration and minor, it is also driven by your own personal interests; therefore, it is most effective when you are the master of your own academic planning.

Please be aware of all prerequisites, corequisites, and other registration regulations for all courses required within your degree. Program planning can be very effective to identify potential courses needed in addition to specific requirements. Refer to section 4.0 in the *Concordia Calendar* for more information regarding registration policies.

You are responsible for registering in and completing the courses necessary to obtain your degree. The *Concordia Calendar* is the final authority regarding program requirements and academic regulations.

Core course requirements may be fulfilled through both major and minor requirements; however, the same course may not be counted toward both concentration and minor requirements. (Example: courses taken toward a History concentration simultaneously fulfill the Social Science core).

Major Requirements

42 credits required to include:

- a) PSY 104 and 105
- b) PSY 211 with a minimum grade of C-
- c) PSY 311
- d) PSY 319
- e) 12 credits chosen from PSY 223, 233, 241, 258, 281, or 351; or 12 credits chosen from PSY 233, 241, 258, 281, 324 or 351
- f) 6 credits chosen from PSY 334, 339, 359, 385, 399, or 421
- g) One of PSY 275, 367, or 477
- h) One of PSY 420, 431, or 435
- i) One of PSY 405 or 400-series

WRI 300 is strongly recommended.

*Note:

If you <u>do not have a 30-level Language Other than English (LOE)</u>, you must complete a 102-level LOE to meet this requirement. It is recommended to take it in the first year of your program, and then complete the 6 credit LOE Core requirement in your second year. If you <u>have a 30 level LOE</u>, you only need to complete the 6 credit LOE Core requirement which is recommended to be taken in your first year of your program.
