

Donor Funded Bursaries

Every year Concordia offers a number of donor-funded bursaries with specific criteria. These bursaries are only available during the fall term application period. The online bursary application must be submitted by the October 15th deadline.

Bachelor of Environmental Health After-Degree Student Bursary (\$2,000)

Donor: Nelson Fok

Two \$2,000 bursaries to students enrolled in the Bachelor of Environmental Health After-Degree program. Recipients must be registered in a minimum 60% of a full course load and demonstrate financial need. Although these bursaries are open to all EH students, preference will be given to single parents or families with young children.

Dr. Xu Limin Bursary (\$1,000)

Donor: Anonymous

Awarded to a student enrolled in the Bachelor of Environmental Health After Degree program. The recipient must be registered in a minimum 80% of a full course load, present a minimum 2.7 GPA and demonstrate financial need.

Edmonton Eskimo Alumni Association Bursary (Two \$1,000)

Donor: Concordia Open Golf Tournament

Awarded to students enrolled in an undergraduate degree program. Recipients must present a minimum GPA of 2.3 and demonstrate financial need. Although the award is open to all students, preference will be given to descendants of current or former members of the Edmonton Eskimo Football Club.

Harold A. Dietrich University Bursary (\$1,000)

Donor: Lutheran Life Insurance Society of Canada

Awarded to a Lutheran student who is a Canadian citizen or permanent resident and in financial need. The recipient must present an acceptable level of scholarship and show sufficient academic and career promise.

Harry and Muriel Hole Bursary (variable)

Donor: Harry and Muriel Hole

Awarded to students enrolled in an undergraduate degree program. The recipient must present a minimum GPA of 2.3 and demonstrate financial need. Annual awards not to exceed \$1,500.

James Miller Memorial Scholarship (variable)

Donor: The late Walter and Esther Miller

Awarded to a pre-seminary student who has declared their intent to enter the ordained ministry of Lutheran Church-Canada. The recipient must be a communicant member of a Lutheran Church-Canada congregation and demonstrate financial need.

Kathleen Doeling Memorial Bursary (variable)

Donor: Crescent Hill Fund, Edmonton Community Foundation

Awarded to students enrolled in the Bachelor of Education After Degree program. Recipients must be in satisfactory academic standing and demonstrate financial need.

Lutheran Women's Missionary League: Parkland Zone Bursary (\$350)

Donor: LWML of the Parkland Zone (Camrose, Didsbury, Drumheller, Lacombe, Leduc, Markerville, Red Deer, Rimbey, Rocky Mountain House, Rosalind, Torrington, Usona and Wetaskiwin)

Awarded to a student who is an active member of a Lutheran Church-Canada parish. The recipient must demonstrate financial need, present a minimum GPA of 2.7, be registered in 24 credits, and have attended or plan to attend Concordia for two consecutive years. Preference will be given to members of Parkland Zone Parishes.

Lottie Mohr Memorial Bursary (\$500)

Donor: Estate of Ms. Lottie Mohr

Awarded to a student preparing for a vocation in church ministry. The student must be an active member of a Lutheran Church-Canada congregation and a resident of Manitoba or Saskatchewan. The recipient must present a minimum GPA of 2.7, be registered in a minimum of 24 credits, and demonstrate financial need. Preference will be given to pre-seminary students.

Mature Student Bursary (\$500)

Donor: Concordia Students' Association

Awarded to an undergraduate student that is at least 25 years of age (as of September 1st), presents a minimum GPA of 3.0, and demonstrates financial need.

Matsuura Family Bursary (Two \$1,000)

Donor: Sandra Song on behalf of Yasuhiro and Hideko Matsuura

Awarded to students enrolled in the Bachelor of Environmental Health After-Degree program. Recipients must be registered full-time or part-time, have completed at least one full-time term of study, present a 2.7 GPA and demonstrate financial need. Requirement: Submit a statement describing how the funds will be used to help their situation.

Paul Scott Memorial Bursary (\$2,500)

Donor: Family and friends of Paul Scott

Awarded to a third- or fourth-year Humanities (Drama, English, French, History, Music, Philosophy and Religious Studies) major/concentration student. The recipient must have a minimum GPA of 2.7 and demonstrate financial need.

REALTORS® Community Foundation Bursary for Disabled Students (\$500)

Donor: REALTORS® Community Foundation

Awarded to a student with a physical, mental or learning disability and who is an Alberta resident. The recipient must be enrolled in a university-level program and demonstrate financial need.

Singhmar Bursary for International Students (\$500)

Donor: Singhmar Family

Awarded to an international student enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate degree program. The recipient must present a minimum GPA of 2.0 and demonstrate financial need.

Student Access Bursary (Four \$2,000)

Donor: Access to the Future Fund – Alberta Government

Awarded to students enrolled in the Bachelor of Management, Bachelor of Environmental Health (After Degree), Master of Information Systems Security Management, and Master of Information Systems

Assurance Management Programs. Recipients must be registered in a minimum 60% of a full-course load, have achieved satisfactory academic standing on their most recent coursework at the time of application and demonstrate financial need.

The Patricia Eidem Bursary for the Hearing Impaired (\$1,000)

Donor: Mrs. Patricia & Dr. Rod Eidem

Awarded to a student with a hearing disability intending to enter the teaching profession. The recipient must present a minimum GPA of 2.7, register in a minimum of 9 credits each semester in the Bachelor of Education (After Degree) program or a Bachelor of Arts degree program with a declared minor in Education, and demonstrate financial need. Preference will be given to students enrolled in the Bachelor of Education (After Degree) program.

Walter and Tillie Rosnau Bursary (\$500)

Donor: Walter and Tillie Rosnau

Awarded to a Lutheran Education student. The recipient must demonstrate financial need.

Yvonne Pitts Women's Bursary (\$250)

Donor: Anonymous faculty member

Awarded to a student who is a mother and demonstrates financial need. Preference is given to a student over the age of 25.
