

Concordia Study Abroad Travel Bursary Application

Deadline: Fall term-October 1 Winter term-March 15

A one-time \$1,000 award (three available per term) to assist Concordia undergraduate students with travel costs to participate in a study abroad semester at a recognized partner institution. The recipient must present a minimum 2.7 GPA, be registered full-time in an undergraduate degree program, be eligible to participate in a Study Abroad program and have a sincere interest in international travel and inter-cultural learning. When there are more applicants than awards, preference will be given to students who are not receiving other Concordia scholarships and awards in the same academic year. Applicants are not eligible if receiving other financial support such as Erasmus+grants.
