Program planning can be very effective to identify potential courses needed in addition to specific requirements. Refer to section 4.0 in the *Concordia Calendar* for more information regarding registration policies.

You are responsible for registering in and completing the courses necessary to obtain your degree. The *Concordia Calendar* is the final authority regarding program requirements and academic regulations.

Core course requirements may be fulfilled through both concentration and minor requirements; however, the same course may not be counted toward both concentration and minor requirements. (Example: courses taken toward a History concentration simultaneously fulfill the Social Science core).

Major Requirements

42-60 credits required to include:

- a) SOC 100
- b) SOC 101 or 102
- c) SOC 210 and 315
- d) SOC 332 and 333
- e) 6 credits chosen from SOC 224, 241, 260, or 261
- f) 12 credits of unspecified senior-level Sociology courses
- g) SOC 405
- h) 3 credits chosen from SOC 418, 425, 460, or 480
- i) 0-18 credits of unspecified Sociology courses with a maximum of 3 credits at the junior level

*Note:
