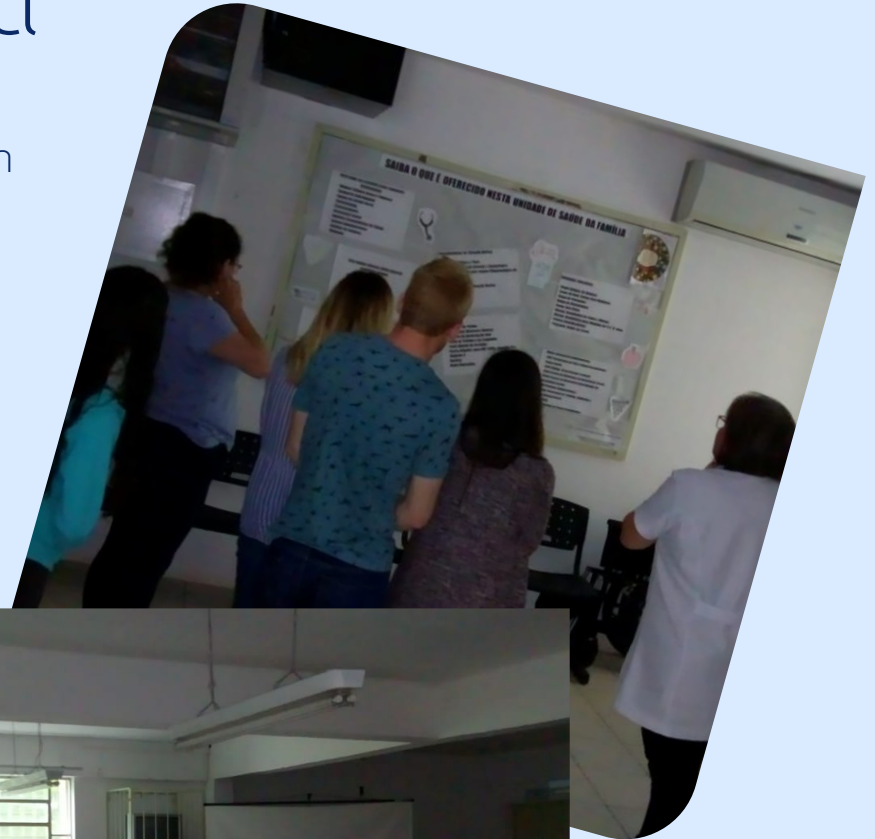

This project promotes interdisciplinary healthcare actions on "Bairro Santo Antônio" (a neighborhood in Lajeado), which contribute on the formation of the students.





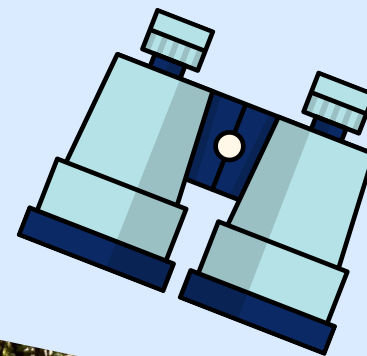
# Visit to Unianálises

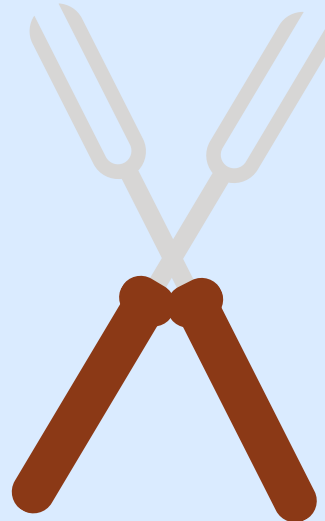
# Visit to "CTG Querência do Arroio do Meio"
