

Lieutenant Governor of Alberta Historian Award Application Form

A \$1,500 award to a full-time student enrolled in an undergraduate degree program who has completed or is currently taking courses in Alberta's and/or Canada's history and who has demonstrated good character, active community service and potential for leadership. The recipient must be in satisfactory academic standing and prepare a maximum 500-word essay.

This award is funded annually by the History & Heroes Fund at the Edmonton Community Foundation. Their Honours, Lieutenant Governor Lois Mitchell and Doug Mitchell, founded the History & Heroes Foundation to advance Albertans' interest in and knowledge of the history of our province and the history of Canada.

Application Procedures

A complete application consists of:

- A signed application form;
- A detailed resume highlighting your leadership involvement and extra-curricular community service activities (please refer to the instructions).
- A maximum 500-word essay (please refer to the instructions)
- One confidential letter of reference (signed, in a sealed envelope) in support of your community service and leadership potential. Using specific examples, the referee will explain how the applicant's qualities and attributes demonstrate worthiness for award consideration.

Essay Instructions

On a separate sheet of paper, write a maximum 500-word statement that answers the following question:

What do Albertans today need to understand about Canada's past?

Your response should discuss one particular event, aspect or theme of Canada's past and why an understanding of it is especially relevant for Albertans today.

Selection Procedures

A selection committee comprised of the Financial Aid and Awards Coordinator, and two representatives from faculty and/or staff will be responsible for reviewing the applications. Concordia's Scholarship and Awards Committee (SAC) will affirm Concordia's recommended candidate. Concordia forwards the recommended candidate's application to the History and Heroes Foundation. The Foundation will ratify the successful candidate and distribute the award.

Lt. Governor of Alberta Historian Award LETTER OF REFERENCE INSTRUCTIONS

These instructions are to be given to the person who will write your letter of reference.

You have been asked to write a letter of reference on behalf of a student applying for the Lt. Governor of Alberta Historian Award (see award criteria below). The applicant has been asked to submit one letter of reference written by an individual in support of their extra-curricular community service and their leadership potential (i.e. volunteer supervisor, professor, former teacher). The referee cannot be related to the applicant. To assist you in the preparation of this letter, please refer to the instructions and information below.

A \$1,500 award to a full-time student who has demonstrated good character, active community service and potential for leadership and who has completed courses in Canada's and/or Alberta's History. The recipient must be in satisfactory academic standing and prepare a maximum 500-word essay.

Instructions:

In your letter, please state the length of time and the capacity in which you know the applicant. Describe their role, their activities and their accomplishments and how their service has impacted the organization or community. In addition, please indicate if the applicant has demonstrated exceptional leadership or shows potential for leadership. Using specific examples, explain how the applicant's qualities and attributes demonstrate worthiness for award consideration.

Please ensure that the letter is typewritten on letterhead (if applicable), signed and includes your contact information. To ensure confidentiality, be sure to seal the envelope and sign your name across the sealed flap before giving the *Letter of Reference* to the applicant.

The applicant would appreciate a prompt response as the deadline for applications is **October 15, 2020**.
