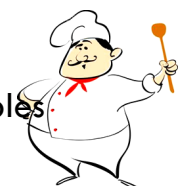

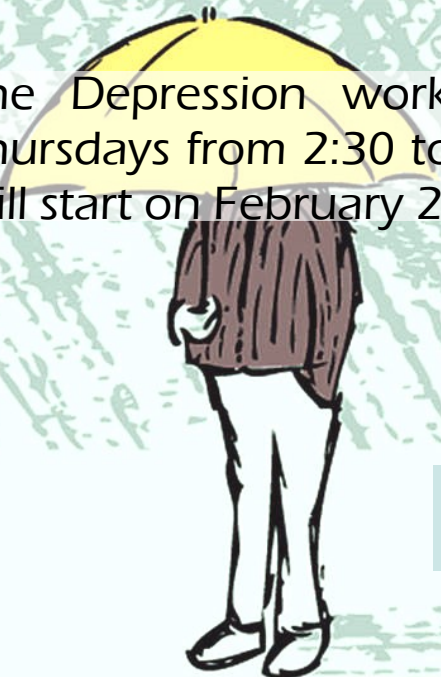
Learn what anxiety and depression are and develop strategies for coping with these disorders.

FREE PSYCH ASSESSMENT

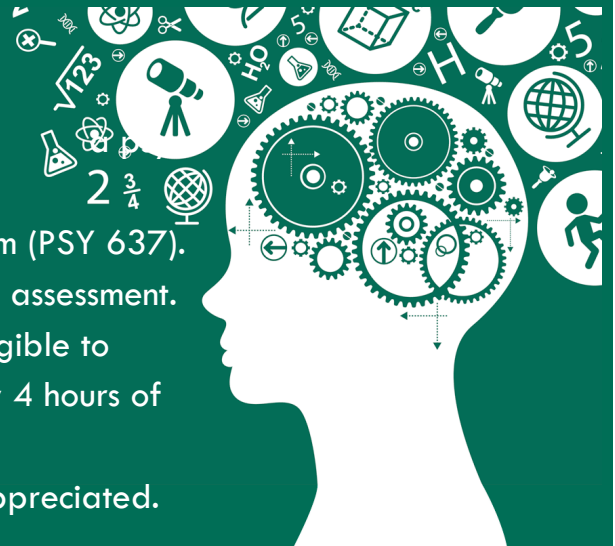
We are currently seeking volunteers to be involved in psychological assessment this winter and in the spring.

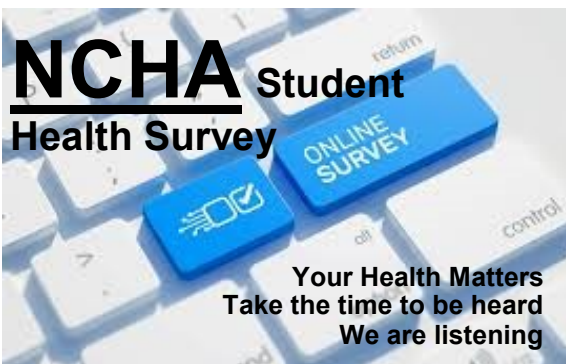
