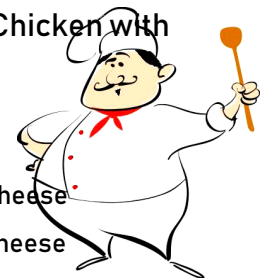

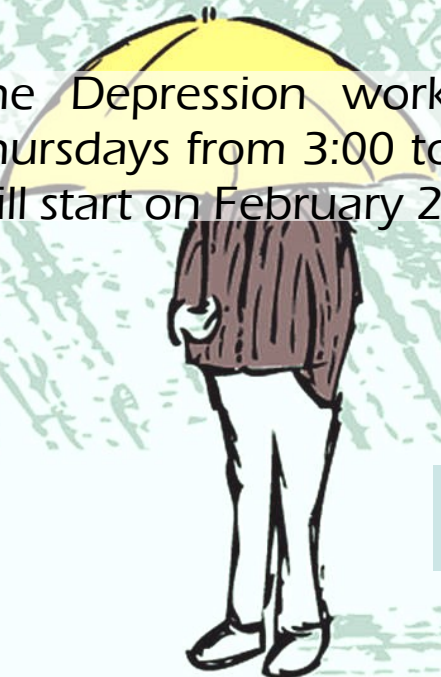
Learn what anxiety and depression are and develop strategies for coping with these disorders.
