

THE PROPS OF MY FAITH OBJECTS AND RITUAL IN EGERIA'S 4TH CENTURY PILGRIMAGE TO JERUSALEM

A female pligrim made a pligrimage to the Holy Land in the late fourth century. Egeria's Travels recounts her impressions of the trip. This text is remarkable: It is written by a female of the ancient world and it has an early date in Christian history (relatively soon after the initiatives of Constantine in establishing Christian pligrimage). Intriguingly, Egeria mentions venerating the incredible artifacts of the true wood of the cross and the inscription which had been above Jesus' head. This talk examines the ritual surrounding these objects, and how it gives us a glimpse into this world of long ago.




USE THE CUE INVOLVED APP TO TRACK AND ADD TO YOUR CO-CURRICULAR RECORD

Scholarships are applicable to female Canadian citizen enrolled in full time studies in STEM bachelor or diploma programs.





Frequently Asked Questions

Can I apply for funding for spring and summer term or spring session?

Yes. Students may apply for full-time or part-time funding for spring and summer term or spring session (EH and MISAM/MISSM). APPLY EARLY as it could take up to 4-6 weeks for applications to be processed and funding issued.

When is the deadline to apply?

Funding applications must be submitted 30 days before the "end of study" date for the term/s or session for which you are applying. Applications received by Alberta Student Aid after this deadline will not be processed.

Will I need to submit more than one application for funding?

You will need to submit more than one funding application if your study terms are not consecutive. You may apply per term or you may combine consecutive terms. Careful consideration must be given when applying for more than one term as courses may be cancelled in one or the other term, resulting in a "withdrawal" notice on your student funding record. We suggest you speak to a registration advisor to confirm which courses may be cancelled before proceeding with your funding application.
