

Extra Mile Award

The Extra Mile Award is awarded to a CUE employee who makes an impact in the work they do. Do you have a colleague who always goes the extra mile in service beyond the call of duty to students, fellowworkers, and the university?

This is not an annual award, and is bestowed only if there is a worthy recipient. When granted, the award is presented at the Concordia Recognition Dinner.

Criteria

- 1. The recipient is someone who goes the extra mile in one or more of the following ways:
 - gives extra time and effort;
 - is cheerful and good humoured;
 - consistently promotes team work by helping and co-operating outside of requirements;
 - exhibits tact and diplomacy in dealing with colleagues or the outside community on sensitive issues;
 - does much for the whole university community serving on boards and committees;
 - volunteers time to help others and has a desire to work for the good of all areas;
 - listens, supports and recognizes colleagues, and/or
 - is visible and recognized by many as deserving the award.
- 2. The recipient is someone who demonstrates integrity in both their personal and professional life.
- 3. The recipient demonstrates a commitment to the Mission of Concordia University of Edmonton.
