- f. 3 credits chosen from ISSM 531 (Advanced Network Security) or ISSM 535 (Firewall Fundamentals)

In addition to the program specific program requirements as given in sections 13.3, 13.4, and 13.5, students in all graduate programs have to successfully complete the Graduate Ethics Training Course **FGS 600** by the applicable deadline for application for graduation, see *Academic Schedule*, section 2.0. Normally, students complete this course in their first term.
