# CONNECT YOUR HEALTH TO YOUR WORLD.



If this program seems unique, that's because it is. It is **one of only six programs in Canada** that can train you to be an **Environment Health (EH) Officer** or **Public Health Inspector**. Environmental health is the practice of protecting public health by applying relevant provincial legislation and providing support to mitigate the physical, chemical, and biological risks found in natural and man-made environments.

Environmental Health Officers work in diverse settings across the public, private, and not-for-profit sectors, as well as for educational institutions and research organizations, educational institutions and as consultants.

Students in the program who choose to take a 12-week field placement practicum can take the Canadian Institute of Public Health Inspectors (CIPHI) certification exam to be able to practice as an Public Health Inspector in Canada.

### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- A three- or four-year baccalaureate degree from a recognized university or college.
- An admission grade point average (AGPA) of at least 2.3 (on CUE's 4-point scale) or equivalent on the most recently attempted 30 credits.
- Successful completion of:
  - 3 credits in chemistry and
  - 3 credits in statistics
- It is recommended that applicants present
  - 3 credits in microbiology and
  - 3 credits in human anatomy or 3 credits in human or mammalian physiology

**In order to graduate, students must present these credits.**

- A statement of career objectives.
- Demonstrated fulfilment of CUE's English Language Requirement.

**Note:** To register in the required course ENVH561 (Field Experience in Public Health Inspection) students will need to submit an immunization record and a security clearance.

Faculty of Education minors include: Early Childhood Education, Education, and Physical Education and Sport Studies.

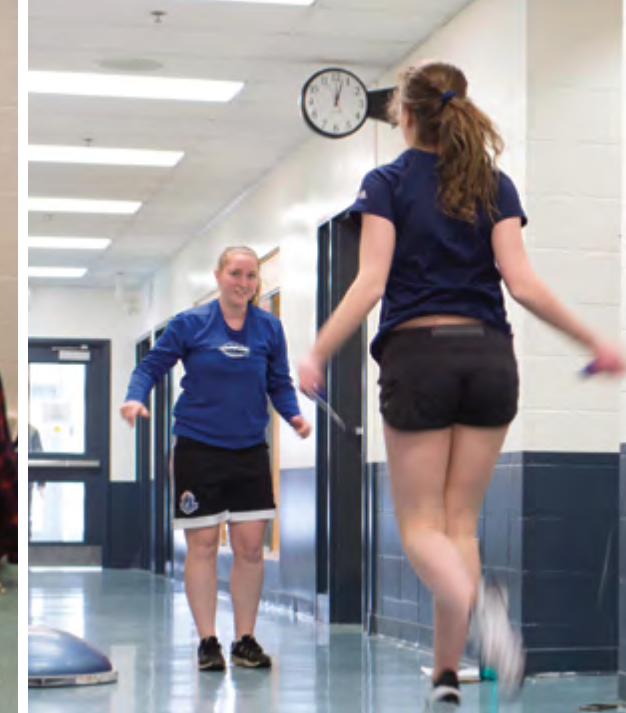

- Meets language proficiency requirement of the host institution if applicable
- In good financial standing

## MANAGEMENT DUAL DEGREE

CHINA

This exceptional four-year program requires students to complete the first year of their Bachelor of Management degree at CUE before heading to China for two years to study at the International Business School of Beijing Foreign Studies University. After returning to Edmonton to finish the program, students receive two degrees: A Bachelor of Management from CUE and a Bachelor of Economics or Bachelor of Management from Beijing.

## ARTS DUAL DEGREE

FRANCE

This unique three-year program allows you to begin your Bachelor of Arts degree in French at CUE, and then complete your final year at Université de Bretagne Sud in Lorient, France. You'll earn two degrees upon completion: Your Bachelor of Arts (French) and your Licence Lettres Modernes (the European equivalent).

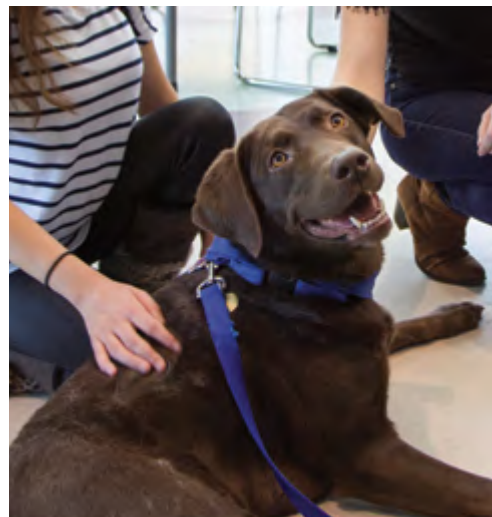

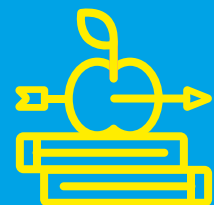

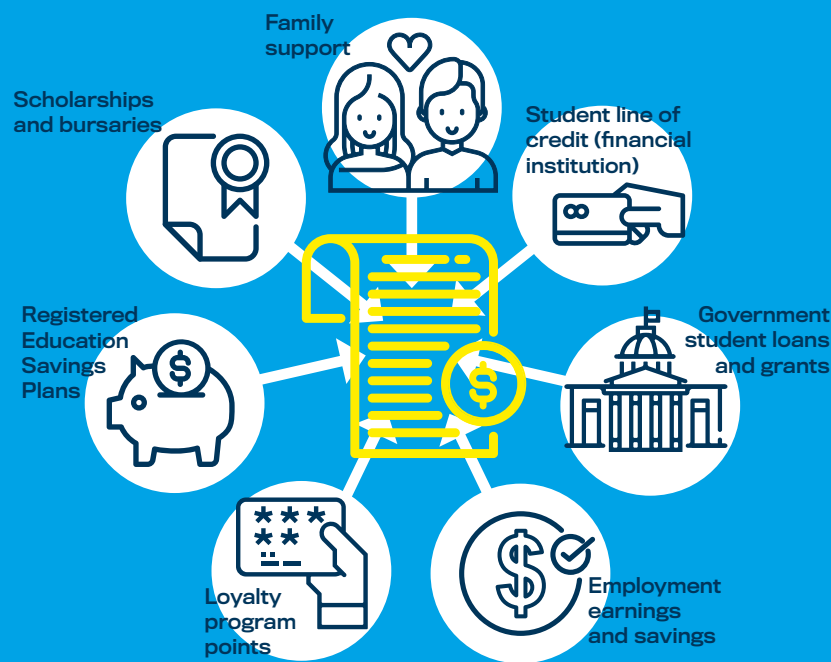

## HERE ARE A FEW THINGS TO CONSIDER BEFORE YOU APPLY

Choose what to study

- **Faculty** – Arts, Management, Science
- **Major** – Consists of up to half of your degree courses
- **Minor** – A secondary area of study which does not have to be in the same faculty.
- **Three-year or Four-year degree** – Not all disciplines are available in both three and four year options

Students take a variety of courses in your first year. Changes to your degree plan after your first year are possible without loss of credit. If you apply for fall admission you will register in courses in March.

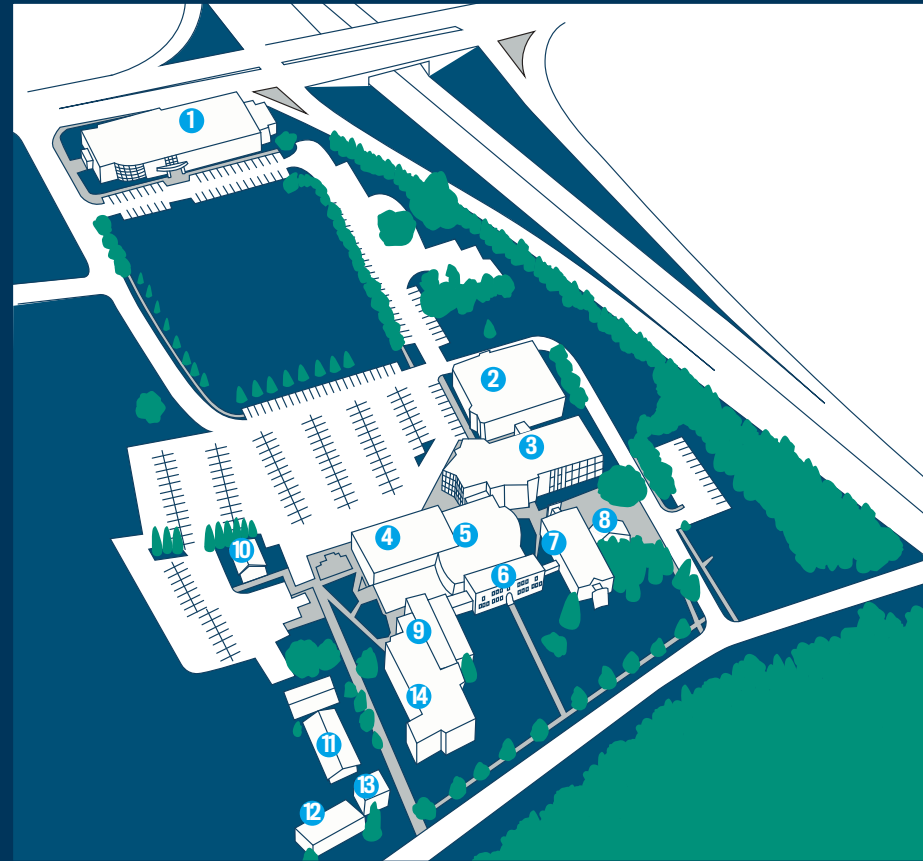
## JUMP START

Jump Start allows students in Grade 11 to apply to CUE with their Grade 11 grades. Students interested in applying early may do so from January 1 – June 15 of their Grade 11 year. Arts and Science applicants must show an overall average of 65% in their Grade 11 courses and Management and Dual Degrees applicants must show an overall average of 72%. Final admission is dependent on students completing their relevant Grade 12 courses and achieving minimum entrance averages for the program they have applied.

## ACCEPTANCE OF AP/IB COURSES

We recognize students who complete their Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate courses and exams. Students who receive a grade of 4 or 5 on the AP exams and 5 or higher on IB exams may be assessed for transfer credits towards courses at CUE. Refer to the current academic calendar for a full listing of eligible AP and IB courses.

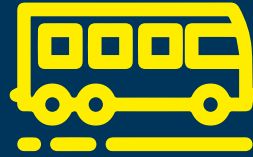
