

Consult with CUE's copyright officer

Ensure your course materials are copyright compliant by emailing CUE's Copyright Officer as early in your course preparation process as possible. This is especially important if you plan to scan copyrighted material (e.g. a chapter from a print book) and share it with your students.

Ensuring that course materials are copyright compliant takes time, and requests for compliance reviews will be dealt with in the order in which they are received.


Our chat, email, and text messaging services provide you with expert assistance without the need for you to come to the library in person.



How are we keeping the library safe? Only visit the library when necessary.

- Plexiglass barriers are installed at all service points
- Co-browsing monitors are set up at all service points
- Floor markers are added to ensure distancing at service waiting areas
- Books and other library items are isolated before they are returned to our shelves
- Directional signage and barriers are set up to establish proper distancing
- Disinfectant wipes and hand sanitizer are available at the Library Service Desk
- Our basement, bookable study rooms, and 3rd floor remain closed

Located on the main floor of the library, this kiosk allows you to quickly and effortlessly checkout library materials using your CUE ID card.




