Orange Shirt Day grew out of Phyllis Webstad's story of having her shiny new orange shirt taken away on her first day of school at residential school, told for the first time in May 2013. It has become an opportunity to keep the discussion on all aspects of residential schools happening annually. Orange Shirt Day is also an opportunity for First Nations, local governments, schools and communities to come together in the spirit of reconciliation and hope for generations of children to come. Phyllis published her first children's book called "The Orange Shirt Story" which aims to bring communities together.

- be registered full-time (minimum 60% of a full-course load) in an undergraduate degree program at Concordia
- demonstrate financial need
- submit proof of Métis ancestry

## WHAT IS THE CONCORDIA COMMITMENT?

The Concordia Commitment, a one-of-a-kind program in Alberta, provides additional support throughout your studies to help you achieve academic and career success.

The Commitment helps you get the most out of everything that CUE has to offer from the first semester to beyond graduation.

If you complete all requirements of the Concordia Commitment program, have a 2.3 GPA at graduation, and do not secure career-related employment within 6 months of graduation, or move on to a professional program or graduate studies, you are eligible to return for an extra year of undergraduate classes for FREE.

## ELIGIBILITY:

All students with 33 or less CUE or transfer credits in a 4-year degree program, and all students with 9 or less CUE or transfer credits in a 3-year degree program are eligible for the Concordia Commitment.

Note that this includes students starting 3 and 4-year degree programs with no post-secondary courses or credit.

Did you know? The Concordia Bursary Program includes donor-funded bursaries specifically for students who are age 25 or older. The Concordia Bursary and other Donor-funded bursaries within this program are meant to supplement, not replace, other financial assistance already in place. Full-time students who are experiencing unexpected financial difficulties may apply.

- 1. Mature Student Bursary (\$1,000) Awarded to an undergraduate student that is at least 25 years of age (as of September 1st), presents a minimum GPA of 3.0, and demonstrates financial need.
- Are you a single mother over the age of 25 studying full-time in a degree program? Apply for the Concordia Bursary Program and be considered for the Yvonne Pitts Women's Bursary.
