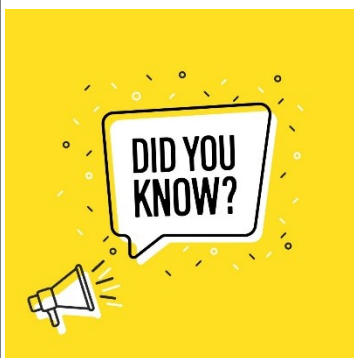
LEARN How to Apply for a CGS-M Scholarship for Your Master's Degree

The Financial Aid and Awards Office is hosting an online presentation regarding the [Canada Graduate Scholarship - Master's Program](#) on **Thursday, October 1 at 4:00 p.m.** Join us through meet.google.com/zvp-nxqo-yet.

This scholarship opportunity is for senior level science or arts students who are interested in pursuing a master's degree after they graduate. The presentation talks about the scholarship, the three granting agencies (SSHRC, NSERC and CIHR) and how to apply (must be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident).

CANADA STUDENT GRANT - In response to the Covid-19 pandemic the maximum amount of Canada Student Grants will be doubled for the 2020-2021 academic year. The Canada Student Grant for Full-Time Students will increase up to a maximum of **\$6,000** and the grant for part-time studies to **\$3,600**.

For those students who have NOT applied for government student aid this year (loans/grants), a Concordia financial aid advisor can help you identify if you are eligible for grant funding and explain how to request grants only, no student loans when you apply. 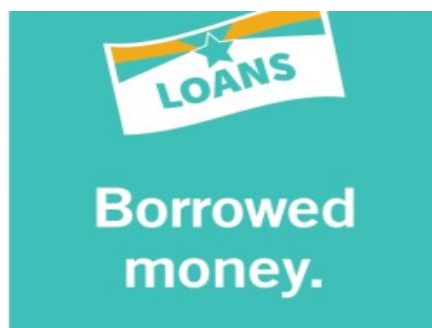

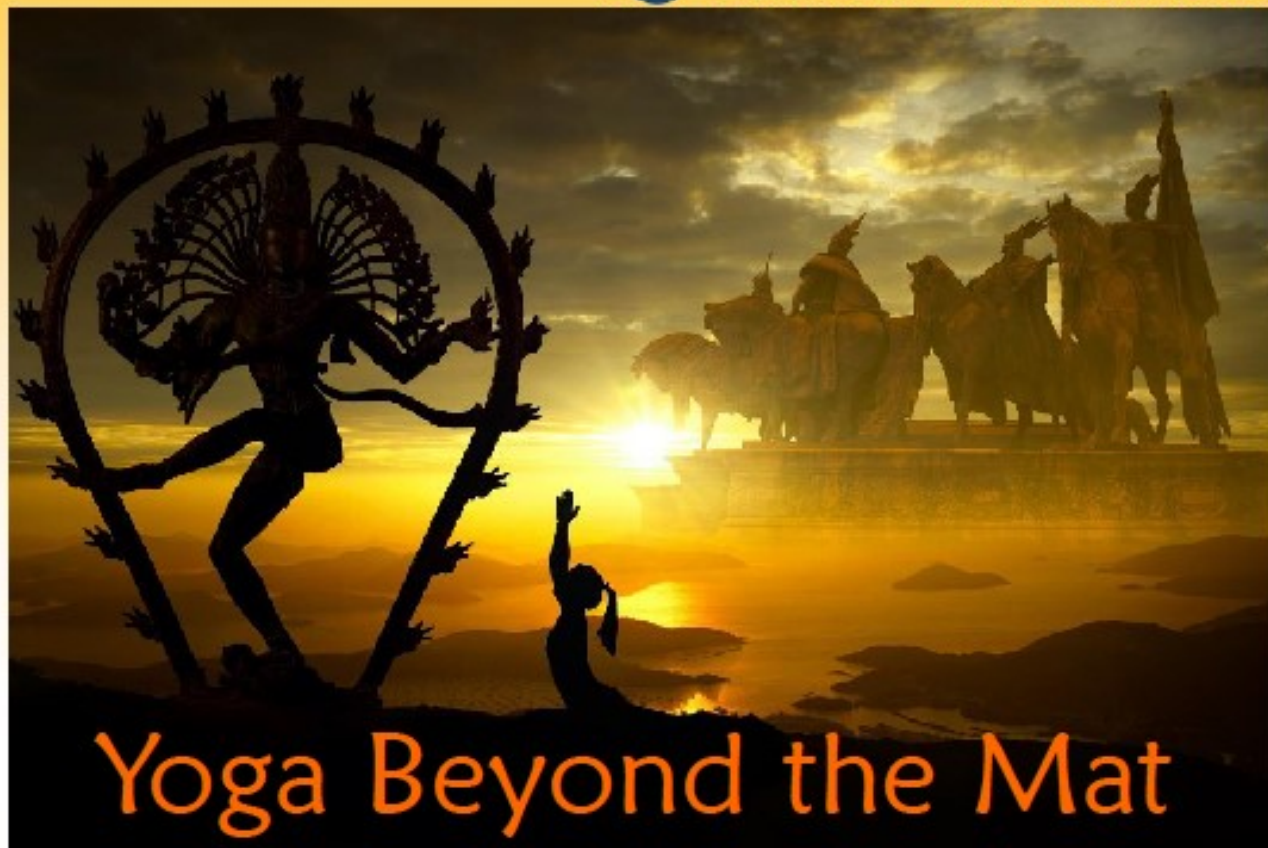

Dr. Marcella Siqueira Cassiano is a Lecturer in Sociology at the Concordia University of Edmonton and the University of Alberta. Marcella holds a PhD in Sociology from the University of Alberta and a master's degree from Shandong University in China. Her research projects focus on population governance, particularly the policies, practices, and technologies that manufacture social conformity and regulate populations in the contexts of work and migration.

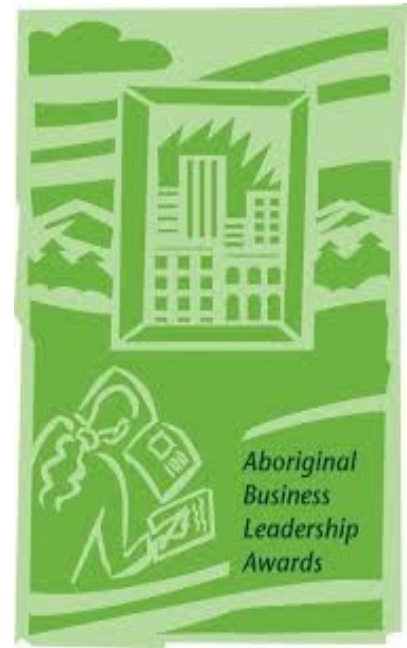
