





# **Financial Aid and Awards**

### **GOVERNMENT STUDENT AID (Loans & Grants)**

**CANADA STUDENT GRANT** - In response to the Covid-19 pandemic the maximum amount of Canada Student Grants will be doubled for the 2020-2021 academic year. The Canada Student Grant for Full-Time Students will increase up to a maximum of **\$6,000** and the grant for part-time studies to **\$3,600**.

For those students who have NOT applied for government student aid this year (loans/grants), a Concordia financial aid advisor can help you identify if you are eligible for grant funding and explain how to request grants only, no student loans when you apply.
