

REOPENING CONCORDIA UNIVERSITY OF EDMONTON PROTOCOLS FOR ON-CAMPUS ATTENDANCE

UPDATE: Until further notice, please avoid coming to campus for non-essential reasons. All on-campus meetings and events are to be moved to a virtual format, and all employees who can conceivably work from home are to do so. Students are still able to attend in-person classes. Prior to coming to campus, please ensure your visit is necessary.

We are committed to taking the actions necessary to protect the health of our community. Recognizing that keeping our campus safe is a community responsibility, your presence on-campus at Concordia University of Edmonton implies acceptance of the following conditions.

You must:

- Screen for symptoms every day that you enter CUE using the [AHS COVID-19 Self-Assessment Tool](#).
- Leave campus immediately if you show any symptoms of COVID-19 infection, phoning 811, and alerting vpsll@concordia.ab.ca.
- Upon arrival, sign in using your CUE identification card. If you do not have your CUE identification, you may be denied entry to campus. Your CUE identification must be carried at all times on campus.
- Maintain appropriate physical distancing (minimum of two metres) from others.
- Wear a face mask in all indoor public areas and wherever appropriate physical distancing cannot be maintained. Any mask may be worn that is suitable for preventing the spread of droplets. While face shields can be worn in addition to non-medical masks for extra protection and comfort, they are not a sufficient replacement for masks.
- Sanitize your hands upon arrival and departure.
- Wipe down areas you have used if disinfecting materials have been provided by CUE for that purpose.
- Only visit those areas necessary for you to complete your business on campus.
- Not bring any guests to campus, including children and/or family members, unless you have received approval in advance from administration.
- Encourage fellow students and/or colleagues to engage in safe forms of social interaction, and to respect the COVID-19 rules in place at CUE. Please note that there are currently no social gatherings of any kind permitted at CUE.

Failure to respect these protocols may result in you being asked to leave campus immediately, in addition to potential further disciplinary action.
