Program Requirements

- 1. 18 credits required, to include:
 - a. ISSM 521
 - b. ISSM 525
 - c. ISSM 533
 - d. ISSM 536
 - e. ISSM 551
 - f. 3 credits chosen from ISSM 531 or ISSM 535
- 2. achieve a minimum overall GPA of 3.0 in the required courses.
- 3. must complete 12 of 18 credits at Concordia University of Edmonton
- 3. complete program within 6 years

In addition to the above program requirements, students in all graduate programs must successfully complete the Graduate Ethics Training Course **FGS 600** by the applicable deadline for application for graduation, see *Academic Schedule*, section 2.0. Normally, students complete this course in their first term.
