Program Requirements

- 1. 30 credits required, to include:

 - EDUC 641
 - EDUC 647
 - EDUC 652
 - EDUC 657
 - c. 3 credits in EDUC 660
 - d. 3 credits in EDUC 661
- 2. achieve a minimum overall GPA of 3.0 in the required courses with no course grade less than 2.3(C+).

In addition to the above program requirements, students in all graduate programs must successfully complete the Graduate Ethics Training Course **FGS 600** by the applicable deadline for application for graduation, see *Academic Schedule*, section 2.0. Normally, students complete this course in their first term.
