The T2202 is your official tax receipt used to claim the eligible educational expenses for the tax year on your income Tax return. The form includes the amount of tuition that can

be claimed as well as the number of months eligible for the education deduction.

The 2020 T2202 is now available through online services for students on Concordia's web site.




