Twice a year the ladies organized days when supporters of Concordia College brought offerings of food to the college, food which kept students from going hungry. Through the years the Ladies' Guild have provided hospitality and financial assistance for the welfare and enjoyment of the students. In the past year they purchased new drapes for the girls' dormitory; they also funded the process of bringing to Concordia the enormous acquisition of books in August 1985.

Dormitory students also enjoy the Birthday Cake Project. Parents of dormitory students may order home-baked birthday cakes to be delivered on their son's or daughter's birthday. The ladies also host the reception luncheons at Open House in August and Graduation ceremonies in May.
