
Graduate Students' Association (GSA) Awards

GOVERNMENT STUDENT LOANS & GRANTS

Who Can Apply for Student Loans? You are eligible to apply for a student loan if you are:

- A Canadian citizen or permanent resident, or designated as a protected person.
- Enrolled in or qualified to enroll full-time in an approved post-secondary program of studies (e.g., bachelor degree, master degree, after degree).

You apply for a student loan through your province/territory of residence in Canada.

Both full-time and part-time funding is available.

Have previous student loans?
If you are not applying for student
aid this year, be sure to let your
student loan lenders know you
are back in school. Do this ASAP
to avoid repayment!




