CAN virtuOWL – Virtual Exchange Opportunity



"We CAN virtuOWL" is a collaboration between four universities from Alberta, (University of Alberta, MacEwan University, Concordia University of Edmonton and Northern Alberta Institute of Technology) and four universities in Ostwestfalen-Lippe in Germany (Bielefeld University, Paderborn University, Bielefeld University of Applied Sciences and the OWL University of Applied Sciences and Arts). The goal of the program is to enable German-Canadian academic exchange and to promote transatlantic networking.

E-Tandem (Virtual) Exchange Opportunity

As part of the "We CAN virtuOWL" project, which included collaborative courses as well as a Digital Student Exchange, CUE students can now participate in another program: an E-Tandem that aims to bring German and Canadian students together for a language and culture exchange.

The E-Tandem works like a normal tandem – CUE students are "matched" with a participant at one of the OWL universities in Germany. You don't need to speak German. You can talk in English or (start to) learn German with your partner if you like. You will get to know each other (for example by video call, e-mails, or letter writing) and exchange information about your home regions, university life, and your cultures. For inspiration, conversation ideas, and a successful E-Tandem experience, you will receive a digital resource package after you have been matched with a student in OWL. You are free to design the E-Tandem as it suits you!

Participation is open to students enrolled in other "We CAN virtuOWL" courses, but also to any student interested in intercultural exchange. Registration takes place via website ([here](#)), where you can fill out a form with your personal details and interests as well as your desired form of exchange. Based on this information, you are matched you with a student from Germany. The program is organized by student assistants from Bielefeld University, Bielefeld University of Applied Sciences, and Paderborn University.

Interested students should attend an information event.

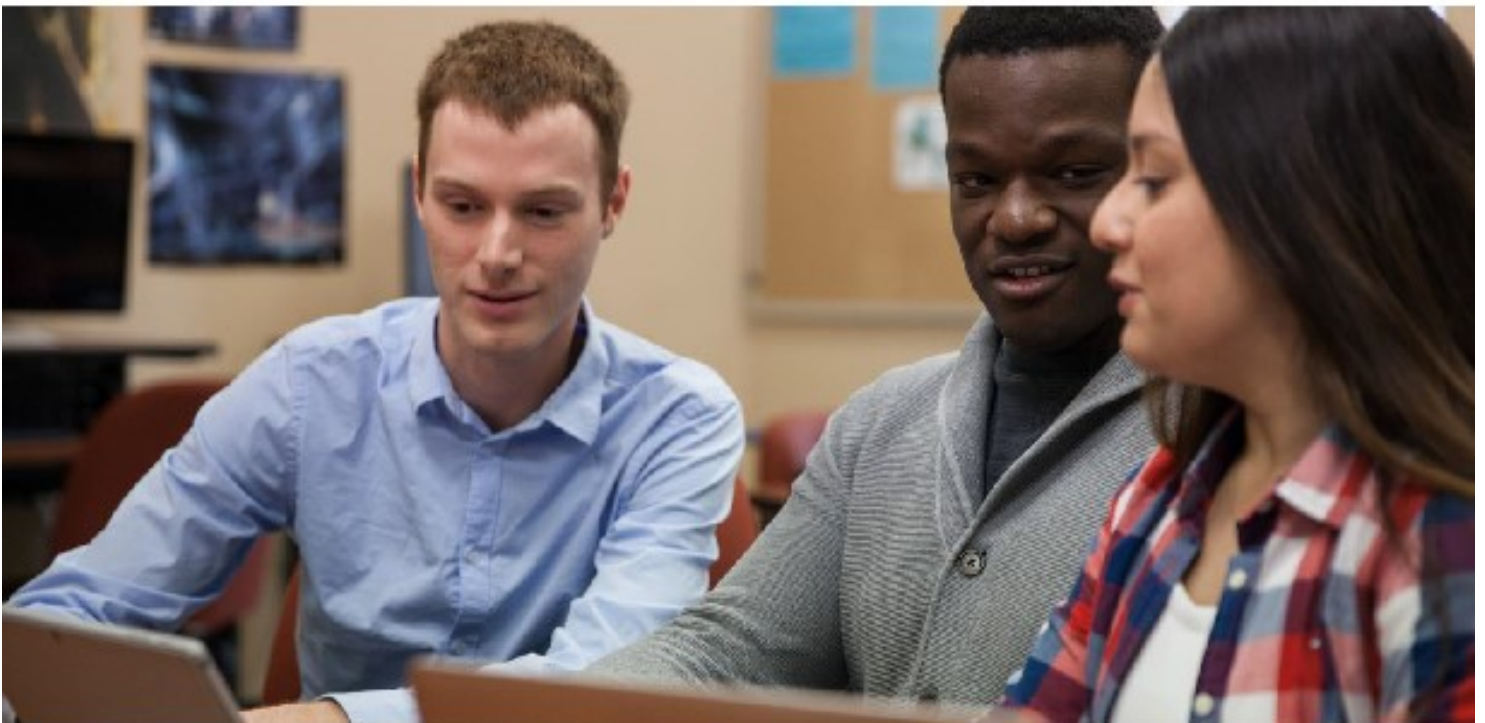
Graduate Students' Association (GSA) Awards
