Join us for a conversation about the history and legacy of residential schools with Grollier Hall survivor, Harold Cook and Resolution Support Program Manager, Rocky Ward.

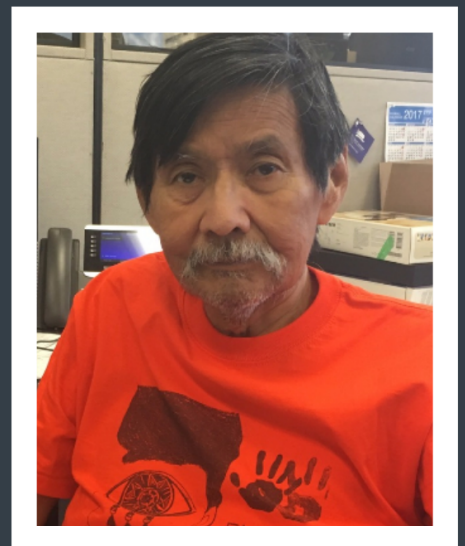
