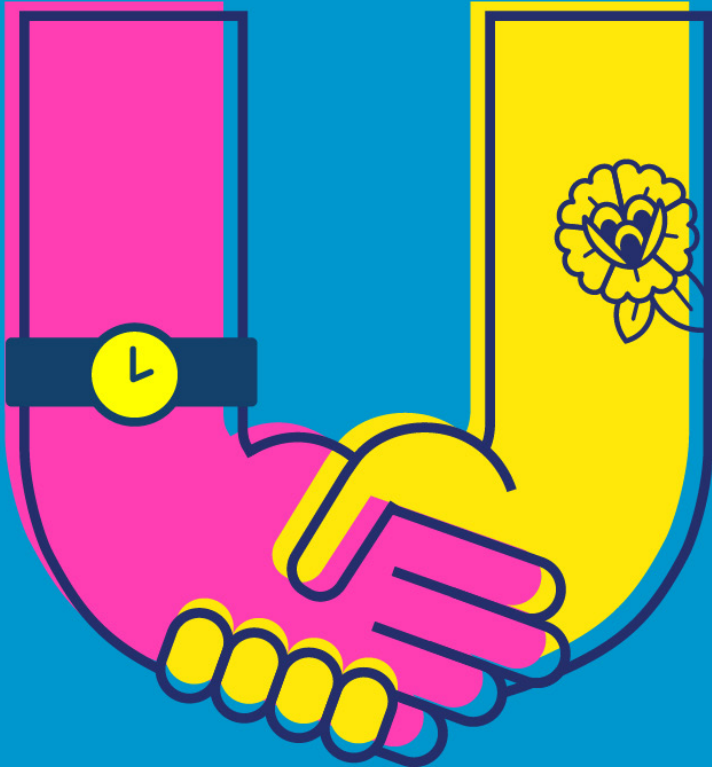

Admission Requirements

Interested? You'll need to present a 65% average, with a passing grade in the following required high school courses:

- English Language Arts 30-1
- Mathematics 30-1 or 30-2
- Three subjects from Group A, B, C or D

**Maximum of two subjects from Group B, each must be distinct. Maximum of one subject from Group D.*

Interesting Courses

ACCT 101 - Introductory Financial Accounting: Learn about the accounting cycle, capital and income measurement, financial statement preparation and analysis, emphasis on reporting to shareholders, creditors, and other external decision-makers.

ACCT 401 - Income Taxation: How does income tax work? Learn about the income taxation system in Canada including the Goods and Services Tax (GST). Students are introduced to the skills required to locate and interpret provisions of the Income Tax Act and assess the implications for decision-makers.
