Admission Requirements

Interested? You'll need to present a 65% average, with a passing grade in the following required high school courses:

- English Language Arts 30-1
- Mathematics 30-1 or 30-2
- Three subjects from Group A, B, C or D

*Maximum of two subjects from Group B, each must be distinct. Maximum of one subject from Group D.

Interesting Courses

LDR 310 - Fundamentals of Project Management: This course provides students an understanding of how to effectively manage all phases of a project. Students will learn the project management framework of initiation, planning, execution, control, and closing. An overview of project management software is provided with students using a specific type to complete a group project.

LDR 402 - Global Strategic Leadership: This course provides students with an understanding of global issues and cross-cultural concepts focusing on people, groups, values and cultures. Students will learn how to build teams of culturally diverse people while respecting local values and maintaining unity of focus and accomplishment. The focus is to understand and respect diversity and how to adapt an organization's best practices to local customs and culture.
