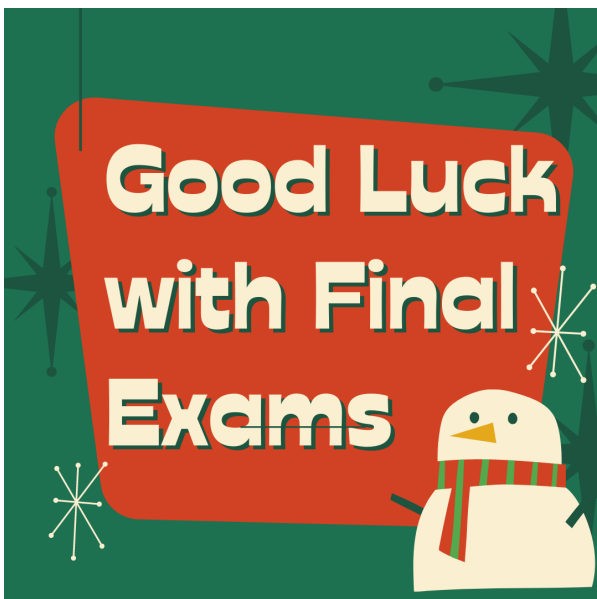

HOW TO PAY YOUR TUITION FEES:

- **Online Banking Bill Payments** – through major banks and credit unions in Canada. Sign into your online banking, under "Bill Payments" add Concordia University of Edmonton as a payee and reference your student ID number as your account number.
- **Credit card payments can be made through PlastiQ by accessing online student services through Concordia's website:** <https://onlineservices.concordia.ab.ca/student/> **! (processing fees apply)**
- **In person payments are not being accepted at this time.**

STUDENT LOANS

If you are receiving student loan funding, please be aware that Concordia is making a payment request from your student loan to pay your winter term fees and these will be applied to accounts in January. Check your account online to determine whether your account has been paid in full after January 15. Students are responsible for any unpaid amounts not paid by Student Loans.

New Student's Starting, Winter Term: Opt-out deadline is January 20, 2022. Students can opt out at: <https://mystudentplan.ca/csa/en/waiver-form> leases ensure that you receive an email stating that you have applied to opt out.

In response to the Covid-19 pandemic the government has doubled student grants for the 2021-2022 academic year. The Canada Student Grant for Full-Time Students will increase up to a maximum of \$6,000 and the grant for part-time studies to \$3,600. For those students who have NOT yet applied for government student aid this year, a Concordia financial aid advisor can help you identify if you are eligible for grant funding and explain how to request grants only, no student loans when you apply.

The Mackenzie King Scholarships

Are you a 4th year undergraduate student interested in pursuing graduate studies?

These awards are based on high academic achievements (typically all A's or very nearly so), personal qualities, and demonstrated aptitudes. Consideration will also be given to the applicant's proposed program of study.



The Mackenzie King Open Scholarship

Value: \$8,500

Open to graduates of any Canadian university who engage in (commence or continue) graduate study (master's or doctoral) in any field, in Canada or elsewhere. One Open Scholarship is awarded each year.

The Mackenzie King Travelling Scholarship

Value: Four scholarships of \$10,500

Open to graduates of any Canadian university who engage in (commence or continue) postgraduate study (master's or doctoral) in the United States or the United Kingdom, of international relations or industrial relations (including the international or industrial relations aspects of law, history, politics and economics).

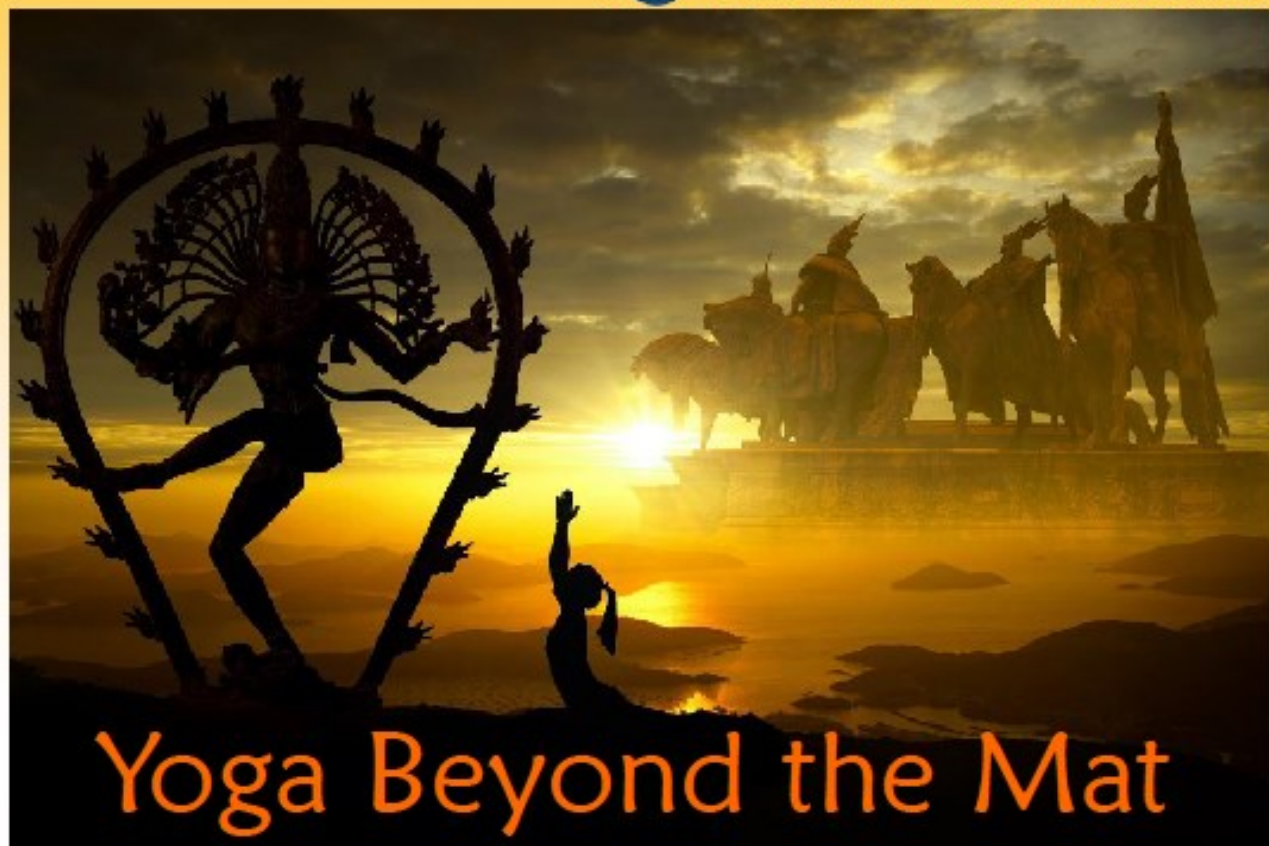
How to Apply: Submit your application documents to Student & Enrolment Services (HA120) by February 1st. You may apply for both scholarships with a single application if the eligibility criteria are met for both.
