Mattinson Scholarship Program for Students with Disabilities

VALUE: \$2,000

DEADLINE: April 15, 2022

The Mattinson Scholarship Program for Students with Disabilities was created to encourage Canadian students with permanent disabilities to pursue university studies with the ultimate objective of obtaining a first undergraduate degree.

Concordia University of Edmonton is accepting applications until April 15, 2022 and will select **one** student to nominate.

Students must meet the following criteria to apply:

- Be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident of Canada
- Be diagnosed with a permanent disability which is documented and is the primary disability for which they are applying*
- Be enrolled in full time studies in a first bachelor degree program**
- Be enrolled in their second or third standing year of studies during the 2022-2023 academic year
- Have a minimum cumulative average of 80% (B+) over the last three terms of available marks

**A permanent disability is a permanent functional limitation resulting from physical, sensory or mental health impairment or a learning disability which affects the ability of the student to perform the activities necessary to participate fully in postsecondary learning.*

***Students with a permanent disability who are on a reduced course load are considered as full-time students for the purpose of this scholarship application, so long as the student is considered full time by their institution.*
