RE: HPV Awareness

Human Papillomavirus (HPV) is the most common sexually transmitted infection in the world. Three out of 4 sexually active Canadians are infected by at least one type of HPV in their lifetime. HPV is very contagious and can be spread through intimate genital skin contact, as well as through vaginal or anal penetration or oral sex. There are many different types of HPV, some of which can cause anal, genital or mouth warts, or more serious conditions like precancers or cancers of the mouth, throat, cervix, vulva, anus or penis. The best way to protect yourself is to get the HPV vaccine. Vaccines make your immune system stronger by building antibodies to help prevent disease. The HPV vaccine has been around for over 10 years and proven to be safe and decrease rates of HPV infections, genital warts and precancers.

As part of Concordia University of Edmonton's commitment to harm reduction and HPV awareness, the university has collaborated with Alberta Health and participating pharmacies to provide free immunizations (paid by the government) of the Human Papillomavirus (HPV-9) vaccine to all eligible students. However, there will be a **25-dollar injection fee** per visit. CUE specific clinics are available on March 17 &18, 2022.

Eligibility

• Includes Concordia students 17 years up to and including 26 years of age

- Dosing Schedule
 - Dose 1: day 0
 - Dose 2: two months after dose 1
 - Dose 3: six months after dose 1

Note: if you received the first dose before the age of 15 yrs, you only require 2 doses six months apart.

If you are unsure whether you have previously received immunization against HPV, you may review your immunization records using MyHealth Records (<u>https://myhealth.alberta.ca/myhealthrecords</u>).

BSwiss - Swiss International Business Summer School 1 to 12 August 2022



Overview	The BSwiss - Swiss International Business Summer School in Basel (Switzerland) is a two-week programme open to Swiss and international bachelor's students. During two exciting and challenging weeks, participants attend courses, visit companies, discover local culture and establish networks with people from Switzerland and around the world.
Objectives	 Every student Gains insight into the most relevant models and methods in the fields of competitiveness, innovation and international immigration. learns from world class institutions like the Federal IPR-Institute. can hone his/her ideas with university lecturers. Group presentations/case studies have to stand the test of the experts. fosters internal collaboration and communication by working successfully in intercultural teams. has read some scientific articles from research journals.
Programme	The seminar focuses on subjects typically taught in the first two years of business application studies: global competitiveness, innovation and international migration. The programme features a guided tour of Basel as well as excursions to cultural and historical sites in the city and beyond; it also includes field trips to different Swiss companies. Company visits provide students with first- hand experience related to the theory discussed in the classroom.
