SCAM ALERT

One of our Concordia community members received a fraudulent phone call late yesterday afternoon.


The caller claimed to be "Officer Tom" from the Concordia security department and accused the person of causing a collision and that he was following up on a grievance from April last year. He had some personal information and asked for other personal information. Fortunately, our

community member was alert and suspicious of the validity of the call and proceeded to ask questions of the caller and when the caller avoided answering they hung up and called Concordia Security on 780 479 8761.

Our community member did exactly what we should do when we suspect something isn't right. Trust your instincts, when something doesn't seem right question the person, if you aren't satisfied with their answer hang up, note down any details soon after the call and contact the organization directly to verify the information. You may also check the Canadian Anti-Fraud Centre <u>https://www.antifraudcentre-centreantifraude.ca/index-eng.htm</u> and report it and the Edmonton Police Service 780 423 4567. If the caller says they are from Concordia Security contact us to verify the call on 780 479 8761 or come and see us in office P106-C.

CATALYTIC CONVERTER THEFTS

Concordia security received a report of a catalytic converter theft that occurred March 14, 2022, near Borden Park. After contacting Edmonton Expo security, we became aware of four further thefts reported to Expo Security as of the previous Friday. We are concerned by this and want to hear from you if you have experienced a theft in the Z parking lot near the Expo Centre or see suspicious activity.

2022 Fessenden-Trott Scholarship

The Fessenden-Trott scholarships were established in memory of the late Professor Reginald Aubrey Fessenden and the late Helen May Fessenden (nee Trott). These scholarships are valued at **\$9,000 annually for three years** (or until the scholar obtains their first degree). Each year, these scholarships are offered to a different region of Canada. In 2022, nominations will be accepted from universities in the Western provinces.

Students must meet the following criteria to apply:

- Canadian citizen or permanent resident
- Undergraduate students completing their first year of their first bachelor degree program
- High academic achievement from both Fall 2021 & Winter 2022 terms
- Demonstrated leadership qualities as evidenced by volunteer/community involvement and/or extracurricular activities.

Concordia University of Edmonton is accepting applications until April 15, 2022 and will select one student to nominate.



Overview	The BSwiss - Swiss International Business Summer School in Basel (Switzerland) is a two-week programme open to Swiss and international bachelor's students. During two exciting and challenging weeks, participants attend courses, visit companies, discover local culture and establish networks with people from Switzerland and around the world.
Objectives	 Every student Gains insight into the most relevant models and methods in the fields of competitiveness, innovation and international immigration. learns from world class institutions like the Federal IPR-Institute. can hone his/her ideas with university lecturers. Group presentations/case studies have to stand the test of the experts. fosters internal collaboration and communication by working successfully in intercultural teams. has read some scientific articles from research journals.
Programme	The seminar focuses on subjects typically taught in the first two years of business application studies: global competitiveness, innovation and international migration. The programme features a guided tour of Basel as well as excursions to cultural and historical sites in the city and beyond; it also includes field trips to different Swiss companies. Company visits provide students with first- hand experience related to the theory discussed in the classroom.
