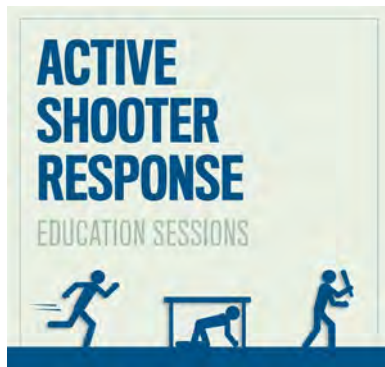

Newsletter Writer

Duties: Creation of a new communication tool for NASAP. Our rescue is looking to launch a monthly newsletter and needs a volunteer to write, edit and design it. Content examples include adoption success stories, information for pet owners, a “vet’s corner” article, an events calendar and classified ads.

Estimated Monthly time commitment: 12 hours (these hours will likely be reduced once the format is created).

Fundraiser & Grant Writer

Duties: The fundraiser develops and coordinates monthly fundraising events and works with the volunteer coordinator to staff them if needed. Fundraising examples include online auctions, and raffles. Grant writing includes researching grant opportunities and completing grant applications for submission.

Estimated Monthly time commitment: 8 hours

Volunteer Coordinator

Duties: Recruiting volunteers, maintaining inventory of active volunteers and coordinating their efforts for volunteer-based events.

Estimated Monthly time commitment: 5 hours

Office Clerk

Duties: Cleaning, sorting and inventory of donations. Maintaining an office presence every second Saturday for 4 hours.

Estimated Monthly time commitment: 8 hours

GOVERNMENT GRANTS – How to Apply

In response to the Covid-19 pandemic, the maximum amount of Canada Student Grants will continue to be doubled for the 2022-2023 academic year. For those students who have not yet applied for government student aid this year, a Concordia financial aid advisor can help you identify if you are eligible for grant funding and explain how to request the grants only when you apply.

Graduate Students' Association (GSA) Awards

The [GSA Bursary Award](#) and [GSA Scholarship Award](#) online application is now open for the Fall semester.

The GSA Bursary Award is a financial need-based award given out each semester. The number of bursaries will vary depending on the funds collected from the GSA fee levy and the number of applicants in any given semester.



Value: \$1,000 for a degree program, \$750 for a diploma program, \$500 for a certificate program; the value of the award may be prorated based on enrolment.
