Internship Opportunities India, 2024 Summer

The Shastri Indo-Canadian Institute (SICI) is going to introduce an exciting initiative with funding support from the Government of Alberta's Ministry of Advanced Education. SICI plans to offer 30 student internships (of all programs) in India, providing mobility grants to Albertan Post-Secondary (public institution) students. These internships will take place in the summer of 2024, spanning 8-10 weeks and will involve Albertan PS students visiting India and working with Indian institutions, including industries and non-profits.

All the costs will be covered including air tickets, visa fees, medical insurance, accommodation, meals, and living stipend.

SICI stands as a remarkable bi-national entity, a testament to the collaborative vision shared by India and Canada. Since its inception in 1968, SICI has dedicated itself to nurturing academic synergies spanning over half a century. It has served as a bridge, connecting knowledge production and the rich cultural tapestries of both nations. With 37 Canadian universities and 144 Indian universities among its membership, SICI operates from its headquarters in Calgary, Canada, and maintains a branch office in New Delhi, India.

While its primary role is facilitating academic partnerships through dialogues, knowledge creation, faculty/student exchanges, fellowships, and internships, SICI has evolved into a nexus that brings together academia, government, businesses, and civil society in Canada and India. SICI has disbursed over CAD 26 million in funding awards and grants between 1995 and 2023, with nearly equal distribution between Canadian and Indian recipients.
