Founded in 1951, Donghua University (DHU) is one of the 72 universities under the direct management of the Ministry of Education of China. It is one of the universities that accepted international students as early as 1954, as well as one of the first batches of 27 universities that have passed the Quality Accreditation for International Students Education. DHU enrolled over 4800 international students from nearly 140 countries before the Pandemic which ranks the 10th among the universities in China. International Cultural Exchange School is the first institute in China accredited by EAQUALS (Evaluation and Accreditation of Quality Language Services - www.eaquals.org) for its high quality in language education.
