
Student Award Letter

Go to Class

New, Updated & Reinstated Alberta Student Aid Policies



You will need to repay all the Government Student Aid received at the start of the semester if you do not attend or drop below full-time enrollment during the first 30 days of the semester.



You can be denied further student loan/grant funding (for 18 months) if you withdraw or drop to part-time from two study periods after attending 30 days.



Students may only receive up to a maximum 12 months of Open Studies funding.
