Since its creation in 1947, CIDEF - which is part of the Faculty of Humanities - offers students and teachers from around the world various programs in French language and culture. The center also provides teacher training courses in pedagogy and didactics. CIDEF has been granted the Qualité FLE label (French as a Foreign Language quality certification), delivers university degrees and is an examination centre for certifications and university diplomas.

THE SUMMER PROGRAMS

The course offer

This study programme is open to anyone over 18 who wishes to take an intensive French course during one or several weeks / months, in July, August or September. 80h/month.

About 20 students per French language class.

TAILOR-MADE PROGRAMS

At CIDEF

This course is designed for:

- Anyone over 18 wishing to study French language and the culture of French-speaking countries for one or several weeks at any time of the year. After taking a placement test, students are placed in a language course and, they can take general French language, French culture or French for specific purposes classes.
- **Groups** wishing to learn a language abroad at any time of the year. The course content and schedule are worked out in collaboration with the group coordinator. Depending on demand, this course may include general French classes, French for specific purposes, cultural classes, activities and excursions.

Online

This course aims to consolidate the students' language skills as well as their knowledge of French culture. After a placement test, the students may access online teaching tools available on an e-learning platform.

Course content is offered through various pedagogical modules that include:

- written and oral comprehension
- grammar, vocabulary and phonetics
- writing skills

Students work at their own ability level and pace according to a schedule specifying the expected time frame and deadlines.

On request students may receive support from a teacher to assist them when necessary.

Excursions

CIDEF proposes excursions all year round. They usually take place during the weekend. In case of a day trip, a packed lunch is required.

REGISTRATION AND INFORMATION

REGISTRATION PROCESS

- 1 Registration form: to be filled in, signed (by the parents if the student is under-age) and returned online, by mail or email. Registration possible at the CIDEF secretariat.
- 2 Tuition fees deposit*: 350 € and 120 € application fees per session.
- 3 Accommodation deposit*: 350 € if you book accommodation through CIDEF.
- 4 Documents to be attached: a photocopy of your passport + a high school diploma or a document proving your registration in your home university + a copy of your private insurance for the entire period.

CONDITIONS

- Minimum age: 18 years old (-18: please contact us)
- High school diploma
- Arrival must be at the beginning of each session (beginner students only)

ACCESSIBILITY

We welcome students with disabilities and needing specific conditions of study.

PAYMENT CONDITIONS

The tuition fees must be fully paid prior to arrival. Payment can be made by transfer, by foreign bank cheque, by cheque, in cash or by credit card at CIDEF.

CANCELLATIONS CONDITIONS

- All course sessions started are due.
- Registration fees and deposits are non-refundable.
- In case of visa refusal (letter from the French Embassy to be attached), the advanced payment of tuition fees will be reimbursed upon presentation of a bank account number. An amount of 470 € (+ 350 € for accommodation) will be retained by CIDEF.
- In case of visa acceptance but cancellation by the student, no refund will be made.
- * deposits will be deducted from the tuition / accommodation fees.
 - tuition fees can be paid by bank cheque payable to a French bank or bank transfer.
 - all bank charges are to be paid by the student.

INFORMATION

The administrative formalities necessary to enter France must be carried out by the student.

VISA AND RESIDENCE PERMIT

You should validate your VISA (VLS-TS) online upon arrival administration-etrangers-en-france.interieur.gouv.fr

- The renewal of the visa must be done between 2 and 4 months before expiration of the visa on the national platform ANEF: administration-etrangers-en-france.interieur.gouv.fr

Note that tuition and registration fees must be fully paid before CIDEF can issue a registration certificate.

INSURANCE

Three types of insurance are compulsory:

- French public health insurance (free of charge for European citizens): registration can be completed online before or upon arrival in France at https://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr If you are an EU citizen, you must bring your European Health Insurance Card (EHIC).
- Home insurance policy (chargeable/included in the price for accommodation via the UCO housing service).
- Third-party insurance

THE STUDENT LIFE AND CAMPUS CONTRIBUTION

For any program exceeding three months, the Contribution de Vie Étudiante et de Campus (CVEC), is compulsory and has to be paid prior to or upon arrival in France.
