Program Requirements

33 credits required, to include:

- k. 6 credits in unspecified graduate (500 or higher) level IT courses

Students must maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0 with no course grade less than 2.3 (C+).

In addition to the above program requirements, students in all graduate programs must successfully complete the Graduate Ethics Training Course **FGS 600** by the applicable deadline for application for graduation, see *Academic Schedule*, section 2.0. Normally, students complete this course in their first term.
