DESCRIPTION

Union 52 Benevolent Society established the CSU 52 Len Douziech Memorial Scholarship in memory of Len who passed away in December 2019 while a member of the Union. Len was a shop steward and he served on the Executive as a Trustee. For nine years, he served on the Members and Community Support Committee including as chair.

As music was a great love of Len and his family, the purpose of this scholarship is to provide support to students entering or enrolled in a music-related program at a post-secondary institution.

ELIGIBILITY

The applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Permanent resident of Alberta
- Accepted as an undergraduate student at a Canadian post-secondary institution in any undergraduate music-related program leading to a diploma or degree
- Not a previous recipient of this memorial scholarship

APPLICATION PROCESS

A complete application must include:

- A completed application form signed by the applicant
- Proof of program acceptance and enrollment in a music related program
- Parts A, B and C as described on page one

The completed application must be received by the Union office on or by October 31, 2025.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD AMOUNT

Funding for one \$1,000.00 scholarship will be available per calendar year. The scholarship will be offered for ten years starting in 2021 and concluding with the 2030/31 academic year.

This memorial scholarship will be funded by non-union dues revenue in compliance with *Bill 32: Restoring Balance in Alberta's Workplace Act*

COMMITTEE PROCEDURES

- Applications are reviewed at the Members & Community Support Committee monthly meeting.
- 2. Selection of the successful candidate will be done by the criteria established by the Committee.

NOTE
