Program Requirements

- 18 credits required, to include:
 - ISAM512 – Financial Accounting and Analysis for Information Systems Auditors
 - ISAM521 – Information Systems Audit I
 - ISAM522 – Information Systems Audit II
 - ISAM542 – Forensic Accounting and Fraud Examination
 - ISAM549 – Internal Audit Theory and Application
 - ISSM538 - Research Methods & Communications
- achieve a minimum overall GPA of 3.0 in the required courses
- Must complete 12 out of 18 credits at Concordia University of Edmonton.
- complete program within 6 years.

In addition to the above program requirements, students in all graduate programs must successfully complete the Graduate Ethics Training Course **FGS 600** by the applicable deadline for application for graduation, see *Academic Schedule*, section 2.0. Normally, students complete this course in their first term.
